

Instructions for students in need of Certificate of Eligibility (Form I-20)

1. Include with your application for enrollment a current bank statement, or letter from your bank in English, which shows that you have or your sponsor has sufficient funds (\$2,000 per month of study) to cover costs for your studies at the IPSA Consortium member English Language School in Boston. The letter must show the US dollar equivalent of the funds available.
2. Read and sign the statement below, or, if the account is in the name of a person other than yourself, have that person read the statement below and sign it too. Please send the signed statement with current bank statement by fax to:

3. Once you are admitted to the IPSA Consortium English Language School in Boston and have received the Form I-20, you must bring this to the US Embassy or Consulate nearest you in order to apply for a student visa.
